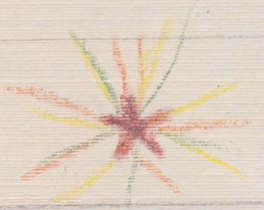

PARIS SHELLED BY MONSTER GUN 70 MILES AWAY BRITISH LINES HOLD

GREATEST BATTLE OF THE WAR RAGEING ON WESTERN FRONT. LOSSES
HUGE; CANADIANS LAUNCH GREATST GAS ATTAC IN THE HISTORY OF

NEWS OF GREAT GUN BOMBARDING PARIS SURPRISES THE WORLD;
Shells fall at fifteen minute intervals but no great damage
is done. Many people fill the streets and no great fear is
